17: Psalm 76 Please pray for the health of some of the TransformNation staff who have fallen ill.

18: 1 Peter 1.1-16 Please pray for the children in villages all over Southeast Asia who will soon receive life changing education.

19-20: Proverbs 8 Pray for the Kids Who Care team (nine teenagers & three adults) traveling to the Slippery Rock children's home today. Pray for God's protection over them & that they would be a blessing to the children at the home.

21: Proverbs 9 Please pray for God to pour His love in & through the Kids Who Care team as they serve at the Slippery Rock children's home. Pray for grace & joy for the leaders at the home as they

bear the weight of hosting the team.
