PRAY FOR THE WORK IN THE LESSER SUNDA **ISLANDS (SUMBA, FLORES, AND KUPANG)**

SEPTEMBER 01 / PROVERBS 25:6-22

Praise God that both students and parents have been applying good habits at home.

SEPTEMBER 02 / ECCLESIASTES 3:1-15

Pray for teachers' health during construction, as some are directly involved in the building work.

SEPTEMBER 03 / LUKE 12:4-21

Pray for the three newly opened classrooms. May God bless these fruitful learning environments.

SEPTEMBER 04 / PSALM 139:1-12

Pray for outreach to villages. May parents' hearts be open to the value of education.



Pray for a fourth-grade student who is still struggling to read due to lack of support at home.

SEPTEMBER 06-07 / LUKE 14:25-35

Pray for a first-grade student, who struggles with reading due to frequent absences and lack of focus, though the teachers are doing their best to help her.

SEPTEMBER 08 / DEUTERONOMY 30:11-20

Pray for all students to grow in their relationship with Jesus, despite the negative influences around them, like smoking, drinking, and glue sniffing.

SEPTEMBER 09 / PSALM 56

Pray for God's protection over female teachers, especially as they face disturbances from individuals under the influence of substances and alcohol.

SEPTEMBER 10 / 1 TIMOTHY 1:1-17

Please pray for better electricity and internet connections, especially for computer lessons which greatly depend on a stable network.

SEPTEMBER 11 / EXODUS 32:1-14

Pray that Serui School remains Christ-centered in its mission: pursuing excellence in education that reflects His compassion and truth.



Pray for the teachers to remain faithful to God's calling and to grow in their faith in Christ.

SEPTEMBER 13-14 / LUKE 15:1-10

Lift up students who must work on the streets to support themselves. May God surround them with safety, meet their needs, and open doors for a brighter future.



PRAY FOR THE WORK IN THE PAPUAN HIGHLANDS **SEPTEMBER 15 / PSALM 113**

Pray for a partner school impacted by a separatist attack, now forced to begin classes online while teachers remain in temporary refuge.

SEPTEMBER 16 / AMOS 8

Ask God to grant peace, protect the community, and bring lasting safety and restoration to the region.

SEPTEMBER 17 / 1 TIMOTHY 1:18-2:7

Pray for unity and understanding in the local community, where there has been tension over having non-Papuan teachers. May God open hearts, and help all parties work together for the children.

SEPTEMBER 18 / LUKE 16:1-13

Pray for teachers who are experiencing trauma and fear. May God bring healing and renewed strength.



PRAY FOR TRANSFORMNATION **ALUMNI SCHOOLS**

SEPTEMBER 19 / MARK 2:17-32

Pray for a faithful school supporter who is under pressure from the community to pay a heavy fine for a crime committed by an extended relative who has fled.

SEPTEMBER 20-21 / MATTHEW 9:1-13

Praise God for the recovery of a teacher who had been severely ill and oppressed by dark spiritual forces.

SEPTEMBER 22 / JEREMIAH 32:1-15

Pray for the health of teachers and students, as many in the village are suffering from infectious diseases.

SEPTEMBER 23 / AMOS 6

Pray for the preparation of junior high classes, including the building, teaching materials, and teachers.

SEPTEMBER 24 / PSALM 146

Pray for the provision of a new classroom building with three rooms to support the growing needs of the school.

PRAY FOR THE WORK ON BORNEO ISLAND **SEPTEMBER 25 / 1 TIMOTHY 6:3-21**

Pray for teenagers from Slippery Rock who are preparing to enter Bible school. May God strengthen their calling and provide support.

SEPTEMBER 26 / LUKE 16:14-31

Praise God for two female students from Slipperv Rock who were accepted into the TfN Program. May God guide them through the transition.

SEPTEMBER 27-28 / DANIEL 10:1-14

Pray for God's provision to repair a kindergarten with damaged floors and a collapsing ceiling so it can remain a safe place for children to learn and grow.

SEPTEMBER 29 / DANIEL 12

Pray for one kindergarten's plan to rebuild and raise the foundation to prevent flooding, as mudslides and uneven ground threaten the area.
